



Thursday, okay, Thursday in Korean? Thursday is Mokyoil Mokyoil, sijak, Mokyoil, han beon deo, Mokyoil, ne, oneureun, today is Mokyoil (목요일) Mokyoil, Thursday, oneureun Mokyoilieyo. Shall we start?





Today we'll cover speaking 2 and more practice, also listening, okay? Yeah. So what is the title of Unit 1? We are still, you know, covering annyeonghaseyo chapter, right? Annyeonghaseyo. OK, yeah, so this is malhagi (말하기) 2, malhagi i, malhagi i, speaking two. So you remember the first one, last time, last time. Let's try this one. OK.

I am Michael, you are Kelly. Let's go. Yeoreobun, mannaseo bangapseumnida (만나서 반갑습니다), jeoneun Maikeurimnida. Annyeonghaseyo, Maikeul ssineun Miguk saramimnikka? Aniyo, jeoneun Miguk sarami animnida, Yeongguk saramimnida. A, ne. Jigeobeun mueosimnikka (직업은 무엇입니까)? Gijaimnida. Gijaimnida (기자입니다). Okay, gija, what is gija(기자)? {Reporter}, Reporter or journalist. OK. A, ne. Do you know what 'a, ne' is? Oh, yes. Oh, yes, okay. Oh, yes. Oh, okay. Ah, yes. I get it. Oh, I see. Okay, something like this. OK. This is kind of a positive response to indicate you are understanding or accepting what you heard. All right? Okay. So a, ne, sijak. a, ne, han beon deo, a, ne, jalhaesseoyo, a, ne, joayo.


Now you are Michael, I am Kelly. Let's go, gapsida, sijak, {yeoreobun, mannaseo bangapseumnida, jeoneun Maikeurimnida.} Uh annyeonghaseyo, Maikeul ssineun Miguk saramimnikka? {Aniyo,} jeoneun Miguk sarami animnida. {Yeongguk saramimnida.} Ah, ne, jigeobeun... Yeongguk saramisigunyo. A, ne, jigeobeun mueosimnikka? {Gijaimnida}. Okay, gijaimnida. Okay, gijaimnida, ne, joayo, jigeop jigeop (직업)

jigeop. Jigeop is occupation or job, profession, okay, jigeop jigeop, can you say it? Jigeop, se beon, sijak, jigeop jigeop jigeop. OK, jigeop jigeop jigeop, ne, joayo, jigeop, jigeop, jigeobeun mueosimnikka? Mueot, mueot (무엇) is what. So what is your job? What is your occupation? What do you do for a living? Yes, he's been one of the top scorers in the Premier League, right? Ne, ne, joayo. Oh, Son Heung-min, saranghaeyo (사랑해요). We can see, Son Heung-min, Son Heung-minssi, annyeonghaseyo, I am greeting, okay, Son Heung-minssi, okay, joayo, Son, Son (全) is his family name, this is family name and this is first name. So in English way, Heung-min Son, but in Korean way, Son Heung-min, Son



Heung-min (손흥민). Son is a family name, okay, family name, surname, family name. Son Heung-min. So most, you know, fans call him Son, right? Son or Sonny, yeah like this right? Yes, yes, okay, joayo, Son Heung-min. Ye, geureomyeon Son Heung-min ssineun eoneu nara saramieyo? Eoneu nara saramieyo? Hanguk (한국) saramieyo, Hanguksaramieyo. I'm so proud of him, right? OK, you guys are also, you know, proud of him, right? Because, you know, he's one of the best, you know, Asian soccer players, right, in the world. He has a lot of you know worldwide fans, right? OK, very good. He is very nice and talented person and he is also very humble, down to earth person. That's why he's admired, I think. So Son Heung-min Son Heung-min, Son Heung-mine gukjeogeun Hangugieyo, which means Son Heung-mineun Hanguk saramieyo, Hanguk saram. OK and jigeobeun mwoyeyo? Jigeop, jigeobeun mwoyeyo? This is kind of a simple template of your self-introduction. Got it? Ne algesseoyo? Ne, ne, joayo. Annyeonghaseyo (안녕하세요)? Mannaseo bangapseumnida (만나서 반갑습니다). Jeoneun, jeoneun (저는), I am, blah blah blah blah, jeoneun nugunugu imnida, jeoneun nugunugu imnida. Our CR's name jeoneun Joelimnida, okay, and then this one, alternatively you can also



say je ireumeun, sijak, je ireumeun, je ireumeun, je (제) means my, ireumeun, my name is Joel, okay? Je ireumeun Joelimnida, je ireumeun Satyaimnida, okay? OK, je ireumeun, my name is, je ireumeun, sijak, je ireumeun je ireumeun je ireumeun, je ireumeun (제 이름은). Jeoneun Indo saramimnida, right? Jeoneun Indo saramimnida.
