Lecture - 01 Introduction to the Course

Welcome to the MOOC course the title to Corporate Social Responsibility. My name is Aradhna Malik, and I teach in Vinod Gupta School of Management at the Indian Institute of Technology in Kharagpur, West Bengal India. And I will be helping you through this course.

Now the reasons for proposing this course first that many many profit making organizations in the world are realizing the value of giving back to society. And we will discuss the history and evolution of corporate social responsibility, and how it came to acquire this shape that it has acquired today. And we will talk about what CSR is, you know why people why business is are choosing to be responsible to the society. Then we will also talk about you know how this whole concept of CSR has evolved over time and what it has come to be and why it has come to acquire the shape that it has acquired today.

After that we will talk about the relevance of stakeholders in corporate social responsibility. We will have a significant chunk of the course dedicated specifically to stakeholders and the stakeholder theory in corporate social responsibility. Then we will also you know the four stakeholders that we have the primary stakeholders or the organization, government, society and the regulatory environments which are a part of the government in India, and of course international regulatory and environments.

And then we will move on to how you can plan CSR activities within your own organization, how other organizations are doing it, and how CSR is integrating with the strategy the company strategy and by that is happening. Then we will talk about implementing CSR activities in different context and in different scenarios. And then we will talk about evaluation of CSR activities. We will have a module on corporate governance, we will have a module on corporate citizenship. We will talk about how corporate social responsibility and corporate social performance linked to the company's financial performance. We will have a discussion on that as well.

And we will also talk about how you can measure the impact of your CSR activities; how you can evaluate the output of the efforts you have put in your attempt to give back to the society that you are a part of. Then you know we will also talk about corporate social responsibility and sustainability. Now sustainability has become a buzz world these days, but we will talk about you know we will dedicate a module specifically to CSR and sustainability. And we will discuss is that in great detail as to how CSR can be integrated with sustainability.

And then we will wrap up the discussion with the future of co corporate social responsibility; where is it going, you know what shapes it is acquiring, what it is likely to be, what are the influences on it, and how these influences are likely to shape, the efforts of organizations and individuals for trying to get back to society.
